form at the time because there were no trees which preserve fossils.

What is more, the author maintains that there were neither flowers nor food for bees 200 millions

years ago. Nevertheless, the professor holds that bees do not have to feed on flowers because they

can feed on pine trees or other things.

Finally, the reading emphasizes that those fossils may not be of bees. On the contrary, the

listening asserts that those fossils are of bees because the chemical substance

of the fossils has

already been tested. (153)
