【第一套】Some people think that it is an important part of children's education to go on field trips (e.g. museums). Others people think a child's time is better spent in classroom at school. Which do you prefer and why?

【思路拓展】

Extraordinary attention as modern education has gained, a wider assortment of education methods is thus provided in order to maximize students' potential. Field trip, such as a visit to the local museum, is believed to be a good practice of dead knowledge on textbooks and is favored by most experts in education. However, this is not a rule most schools follow, and there must be reasons.

First of all, field trip is a big distraction. Although many people, including teachers and parents, tend to believe that when students are shown of the knowledge in person, the words on textbooks will come alive, but this contradicts what exactly happens on spot. Last time when I was in the local museum, I met a group of primary school students, led by the school teachers. Compared with the surroundings in class where everything is intentionally arranged in connection of study, there are too many distractions out in the field.

Additionally, field trip increases the possibility of accidents. It is acknowledged that the number of students enormously outweighs that of teachers in school, and guarding into every student seems impossible. However, the destination of field trip is usually located miles away from the campus and students get handful even when confined on the bus, let alone when they are scattered in every corner of the field. Therefore, in order to minimize the possible danger, few schools will arrange field





trips, however much they may contribute to study.

Moreover, field trip increases the cost of education. Cost of education, undoubtedly in every country, is high, especially when the child goes to private school, where quality of education is said to be beyond normal as well as expenses. To begin with, cooking is the bond between every family member. In China, it is the routine that during the New Year Eve., the whole family will come back from different places and sit together at table, having food delicately prepared by mother. When asked of the flavor, there might be varieties of answers, but one thing must be referred to by everyone questioned, which is the taste of home. That can also explain why families come all the way back home, some of which even take more than a day. And it must be the same case with the Christmas tradition in western cultures, because family connection in the form of home-made food will never wither regardless of time and distance.





Moreover, cooking at home matches the idea of healthy lifestyle. Admittedly, cuisines well prepared in those fancy restaurants are of extra attraction to those who are bored by home-made food every day. However, the public have been aware of the disadvantages of dining outside. For example, people keep concerning about the quality of ingredients, and even if food safety is not a problem under the regulation of government, the way of cooking is also a trouble. The cooks, in order to make the food tasty, tend to put extra sauces, such as those spicy and sweet, which add up the calories food takes and causes weight problem. Therefore, an increasing number of white-collar workers, health-conscious, begin to prepare food at home and take dinner to work every day.

Besides, modern technology has made cooking with less trouble but more joy. For example, in China, there is a kind of traditional food, known as Zongzi, well wrapped with a piece of palm tree leaf containing glutinous rice and pork. It is annually made during Dragon Boat Festival and can be kept for more than a year without going bad. The problem is, in the past, when people wanted to heat it, the only way was to steam it, which took about 15 minutes. But after the invention of micro-wave oven, the Chinese only need to throw the Zongzi into the cooker, and wait for 3 minutes. Admit it or not, cooking becomes much earlier.
