Background Knowledge: 找出來! 找出來! 它叫—Imprelis!

Evergreen plants are usually needle-shaped. The leaves and seeds are attached to the scales of a woody, braced cone. They are durable in a wide range of temperature. However, a new lawn weed killer, or generally addressed Herbicide is killing evergreen trees along with dandelions throughout Pennsylvania and many other states, according to a class-action lawsuit filed Monday. Tree owners started complaining several weeks ago about the mysterious browning of their evergreens, soon after landscapers applied DuPont's new Imprelis herbicide. In our article, it may be about Norway spruce and white pine.

Reading: Against such idea that Imprelis killed the evergreen trees

- 1. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency approved Imprelis last year for commercial use in controlling dandelions, ground ivy, violets, clover and other weeds in lawns. The evidence is quickly piling up that Imprelis is attacking trees as if they are weeds." However, prior to really launching it to the sales in the market, EPA has done many experiences and no other damages were shown to the evergreen trees.
- 2. Uneven Pattern: The damage has been somewhat of a puzzle. Not all the evergreen trees are infected.

While some evergreens near Imprelis applications have experienced damage ranging from twisted and yellowed new growth to total brownouts, others haven't been noticeably affected. Therefore, such spotty injury might be related to the soaking spring, not this kind of chemical.

3. When Imprelis was first used last fall, USA experienced drastic weather changes, such as droughts and high temperature in alternation. such Imprelis injury also can be mistaken for other problems such as bugs, disease, lingering drought symptoms from last summer and branch-tip dieback when hot, bright conditions follow a cool, cloudy period. So, simply put, the withering phenomenon for the evergreen trees was caused by nature, not by human.

- 1. The major tests and experiments done by the government before this product launched the market are for humans and animals. That is to say, those experiments are testing the toxic to mammals rather than to the existing plants.

The mountain yellow-legged frog was once the most abundant amphibian in the Sierra Nevada and Transverse Ranges of Southern California. Only a few decades ago, it was difficult to walk around many of California's alpine lakes without tripping over these diminutive "mountain gnomes." Today the hardy survivors of freezing, high-elevation winters are vulnerable to a host of modern threats, which have driven the frogs extinct in more than 93 percent of their old mountain homes.

Reading:

Amphibians are natural prey for many predators, including fish and birds, which is one reason they are considered important to any ecosystem. Usually, preys develop ways to avoid predators or identify safe places where predators are not abundant, which helps the prey continue to reproduce. The natural balance can be thrown off if humans introduce new predators to an ecosystem. The number of yellow-legged mountain frogs has brought to a harmful declining number in the local area.

1. Introduced fish species (Trout 鮮魚)

Trouts were introduced to lakes and streams throughout the Sierra Nevada in the late 1800s to increase recreational fishing in the area. The fish feed on tadpoles, a main prey item. The introduced trout have changed the distribution of several native species in the local ecosystems. After the removal of fish from several lakes, the frog reappeared and its populations increased. It then began to disperse to other suitable habitats nearby.

Around the world, humans have moved dozens of species of fish, crayfish, and even other frogs to lakes and rivers where they were once absent. In California's Sierra Nevada mountain range, private citizens and government agencies have carried trout into the back country and stocked lakes that once provided breeding habitat for mountain yellow-legged frogs. Scientists now believe that those fish, which eat eggs and tadpoles as well as the insects the frogs rely on, helped push the yellow-legged frogs from their habitat to the edge of extinction. In the Western United States and South America people have introduced large bullfrogs that are native to the Eastern United States. Those bullfrogs, once settled into their new homes, have been found to eat smaller native frogs and to generally take over the habitat of the native frogs.

2. Pesticides

Environmental pollution, including pesticides, is also considered a major cause of amphibian declines. A few characteristics of their physiology make amphibians directly vulnerable to poisoning from pollution. Adult and juvenile amphibians have permeable skin that allows gases and chemicals to quickly leach into their internal organs. Most lay eggs with a soft, jelly-like covering that provides little or no protection from the outside environment. And most eggs hatch into larvae or tadpoles that are vulnerable to contaminants in water. Frogs that have been reintroduced to water bodies cleared of fish have failed to survive due to such pesticide being widely used in that time. Pesticides are considered by some authorities to be a greater threat to the frog than the trout.

3. Fungal Diseases→Chytridiomycosis (兩棲類壺菌感染症)

This species is one of many amphibians affected by the fungal disease chytridiomycosis. Ample research has explored the biology of the fungus and how to prevent related amphibian declines. The fungus attacks keratinized areas of a frog's body. Tadpoles are not severely affected because only their jaw sheaths and tooth rows are heavily keratinized. Infection in a tadpole can be identified by changes in the pigmentation of these parts. Adults have keratin-rich skin and suffer worse infections. In studies, well adult frogs exposed to infected frogs for at least two weeks developed the disease. Transmission takes longer in tadpoles, generally over seven weeks. Frogs may be predisposed to infection if their immune systems are weakened by other factors, such as pesticide. Studies indicate that R. muscosa is naturally more susceptible to the chytrid fungus than many other frogs to begin with.

Listening:

- 1. To begin with, the serious declining number of the yellow-legged mountain frogs is not due to the introduction of trout fish. This kind of fish had been happened before the declined population of frog as early as 100 years before. Besides, there were many places and spots that had been introduced such fish to the location. In other words, the visible frog population was observed only forty to fifty years ago and the declining location is also varied. So, it is clear that the introduction of trout is not the cause for the declining, for the location and timing are not all matching.
- 2. Secondly, if the pesticide is the cause of the serious declining in the population of the frog, we must be able to trace back the source of such pesticide. To put it differently, the pesticides used go to rivers or streams that are flowing downward, such as going to the valleys or the lower areas of the water at the downhill. However, in this case, frog population in higher lands and rivers is also decreasing drastically. The polluted water by pesticides does not go up from those polluted areas to the uphill that is estimated more than 100 kilometers. Therefore, the pesticides are not the cause of the declining for sure.
- 3. Thirdly, amphibians are great natural living beings. They live in a damp, dark and an environment full of bacteria and of course fungus. So, they have evolved to adapt to such inclement surroundings. The skin of frog can produce chemical to protect them from infecting fungal disease. They will not hurt by this natural thing imposed on their skins.

Even though each customer has his or her own favor, yet people working in the bakery should all take the advice and try to come up with solutions. Those honest ideas and opinions may make the bakery feel annoyed or even disagreed. Besides, it is hurting to tell the seller what he or she sells, taking cakes for example, taste like cupboard, too sugary, or too expensive. However, the honest advice will make sellers refine their cakes and polish

the whole making process in order to stand out their products in the field. Thus, disagreement may appear when the honest statement is made, yet it will make people try to do a more promising job, which is certainly advantageous in the long run.

Nobody should hide their opinion. Sometimes the majority are just wrong. If nobody states a differing opinion, nobody will ever have to think. Things that could be better will never improve because everyone is drowning in agreeableness. For instance, a student studies very hard and he does not acquire good score in the subject, such as math or physics. When his friend finds out the situation and discovers that he thinks he already studies hard and he studies math and physics like geography and history subjects. It takes courage to speak honestly if you know the problem and state honestly that your friend does not study hard enough and people cannot study math and physics like history and geography classes. This hurts and may bring strong aversion toward you. However, if you still keep silent and do not express honesty, your friend will never obtain expected score and may end up feeling despaired. 

Background knowledge:

The fashioning and painting of ceramics was a major art in classical Greece. Native clay was shaped easily on the wheel, and each distinct form had a name and a specific function in Greek society and ceremonial in many purposes, such as vessel for wine, corn, oil, or honey or for cooking and decoration.

Reading:

There are three main functions for the ceramic disk recently unearthed. For those disks, the bottom part of the disk has special motifs and patterns, while the upper side of it is undecorated and plain.

- 1. Ceramic disk cooks more evenly than most metal pans that have heat lingered for a long period of time after heating up, making it ideal for this purpose—cooking. Besides, the contour of the disk looks like something that can retain water. Thus, the ceramic disk recently found can be used as a cooking pan for rice and other food that are best enjoyed warm.
- 2. For the shape of the ceramic disk, it is a cylindrical container with a flat top and bottom that it is a hollow frame enabling the sound to be produced. In other words, it is used as a musical instrument, such as a drum.
- 3. The ceramic disk can also be used as a mirror since it is flat on the surface and is not decorative on the top. Along with the hollow characteristic, it can be used as a holding utensil for olive oil or for water.

Listening:

- 1. The ceramic disk discovered in the recent time cannot be used as the cooking utensils or for anything related for this purpose. The shape does look like a utensil that can be used to retain water and other liquid; however, if this is the case, there should be cooking stains or burning marks on the surface of the disk. Yet, there are no traces of burning stains found. Thus, such disk is not used as cooking tools.
- 2. The ceramic disk cannot be used as a drum. It is hollow and can produce sound for sure, yet the quality is inferior. In other words, there are other materials that can be made for this "drum" purpose, such as wood that produces better sound and is lighter. To begin with, families are the people we spend more time with in our early stage of life. People learn important things in the family since they are born in the same environment in which they spend time together sharing and talking to each other. For instance, when a child goes home from school, he or she meet his family first and talk with them about what happens at school. 

Reading:

The Sterile Insect Technique (SIT) is an environment-friendly, species-specific method of insect control, which has been described as "birth control for insects" SIT has been used very successfully in agriculture for over 50 years. SIT works by releasing sterile insects of a target species. The sterile males compete with the wild males for female insects. If a female mates with a sterile male then it will have no offspring, thus reducing the next generation's population. Repeated release of insects can eventually reduce the insect population to very low levels or zero and hence reduce the damage or spread of disease. SIT has been used very successfully in agriculture for over 50 years but is currently restricted by the need to irradiate the insects to sterilize them. For some species, for example mosquitoes, the dose required to sterilize the males also damages their fitness to the extent that SIT cannot be used effectively.

As wild female mosquitoes mate released engineered 'sterile' male, progeny will inherit the lethal gene and die. This method therefore suppresses the mosquito population without using any toxic chemicals. Furthermore, the sterile males actively seek out wild females to mate. This use of genetics means that the Sterile Insect Technique, which has been extremely successful in agriculture, can now be applied to mosquitoes that spread dengue fever.

- 1. It reduces a great number of mosquitoes on the targeted species fast.
- 2. Those engineered sterilized male will inherit the lethal gene and it passes down the gene to the next generation decreasing the number of the mosquitoes. Further, if one were bitten by a female sterile mosquito it would be exactly the same as a bite from a wild one.
- 3. This method is totally environmental friendly. Mosquitoes are dead without using any toxic chemicals.



Listening:

The DNA altered mosquitoes offer potential relief from malaria and dengue, which remain untreatable, unpreventable diseases in much of the developing world, there is still a lot of skepticism, mistrust and even fear of genetically modified organisms of any sort.

- 1. The sterile males will mate only with females of the same species, so there is no direct impact on other species. However, with the reduction of the targeted mosquito, other species of mosquito can increase greatly. Such mosquitoes can also carry diseases harmful to human beings. Or even worse, some species of mosquito may carry stronger virus that are fatal to human beings.
- 2. Even though only the female mosquito bite people for survival reasons, what will happen if the DNA engineered male mosquito accidently bite people. Will that hurt and injure human beings in a new way? We still do not know.
- 3. By experiments, the GM mosquitoes only mate with their species, so it seemingly will not hurt the environment; however it will hurt other species. A recent news story reported that the monarch butterfly population is down by half in areas where Roundup Ready GM crops are doused with ultra-high levels of herbicides that wipe out the monarch's favorite milkweed plant.

正文:

For university education, there are no definite answers regarding what is right and what is not right in terms of taking courses. Some people think that students can take as many courses as possible in one semester, while others think that they should do something else and take only few courses. In my opinion, I am more in favor of the latter—taking three to four courses in one semester instead.

To begin with, taking fewer courses in one semester enables college students to search for their interests. With fewer academic workloads from the courses students take, they can have more opportunities to take part in extracurricular activities so that they can meet new friends, learning from one another. Many great entrepreneurs, such as William Henry Gates met Steve Ballmer, who co-founded Microsoft as well as Mark Zuckerberg, best known as one of five co-founders of the social networking website—Facebook—met Peter Thiel who invested in the company. Had they taken many courses and spend most of their time in the academic work, they would not have opportunities for those great encounters. Besides, nowadays students go to university not for what they really like, but by demands of their parents or even simply follow their friends. So, if they take fewer classes in one semester, they will have plenty of time to look for what they really desire to take and learn in college, which is not just advantageous for their career, but also for their devotion on the academic work.

In the second place, by taking fewer courses in one semester, students can pore deep over their academic work. Undoubtedly, for college courses, it takes not much effort to simply pass the course; however, for a more profound level, if they yearn to learn the course in a more professional way, they must take extra time out for it. Thus, if students only have to deal with a workload within their power, they can spare more time study not just the textbook, but knowledge relevant to it. For instance, for English major, they can read novels related to the author introduced by the textbook; they can also use their time to take part in volunteer jobs in International English Teaching Program helping the poor to learn English or in YMCA, Young Men's Christian Association, to really practice the language in such social groups. For Tourism major or Finance major, students can try to join groups to help them learn the market and people that will help them connect what they learn at school to what really goes on in the society and in the world. Without taking too many courses, students can certainly study more, learn more and perceive more by using the time more appropriately.

Of course, college students taking as many courses as possible in one semester have many advantages. For one thing, they can graduate from school faster so that they can make use of the time saved looking for jobs while their classmates who take fewer courses are still working on their credits. For another, taking more courses in one semester means they really need to organize their schedules well without leading a college life full of parties, part time jobs or fooling around with no learning since average college students do not manage their time well. Nevertheless, college life is the time when students can explore their world other than books and take times out for interests outside books. Thus, I agree with the statement that taking few courses in one semester for college students is a more sagacious choice.





Background Reading:

An estimated 300 million to 1 billion birds die each year from collisions with glass on buildings, from skyscrapers to homes. Birds simply can't tell reflection from reality. Even if a bird flies away after striking a window, it may die elsewhere as a result of the collision.

- 1. There is an effect way to stop the collision of bird into the glass—that is to put stickers or other objects on the outside surface of the window. This is so-called the one-way-window where people from inside the building can see objects through the glass, while the birds from the outside cannot see through the glass, so it produces refection just like a mirror and will thus avoid deadly collision. To put it differently, such glass appears transparent to our human eyes but are visible to birds.
- 2. Applying tape, film, paint to the exterior of the glass is also an effective deterrent against bird strikes on the windows, serving as visual barriers. Another similar ways to prevent bird crashing into the window is to apply visible markings to the outside of windows in patterns that the birds can see while requiring minimal glass coverage to keep your view unobscured. From a research, we know that most birds will avoid windows with vertical stripes or horizontal stripes spaced in a specific distance. This is very visible to the flying birds.
- 3. Magnetic fields: Some bird deterrents emit a magnetic field to disrupt birds' geomagnetic orientation and encourage them to avoid flying toward the area. When birds fly nearby the areas that are magnetic applied, they sense it quickly by nature and will avoid hitting the glass or window.



Listening:

- 1. Millions of the birds die every year flying into windows, because they cannot tell reflections from trees, plants and sky. Covering the glass with a one-way transparent film that permits people on the inside to see out, but makes the window appear opaque on the outside seems like a great idea. However, birds will still bump into the glass since they still look like the scenes in nature. The window is reflecting the surrounding habitat, and birds can't tell the difference, so this kind of visual barrier still not work because birds cannot distinguish it.
- 2. The visual barriers on the glass seem protective to birds since they can see such barrier. However, for the stripes, it still has left some space that is not covered up by stripes. Further, not all the painted or taped glass is covered with colors. In other words, birds still collide with glass that is transparent or non-colored.
- 3. Birds can sense magnetic fields for sure; however, this is not effective at protecting birds from window collisions. Why? When flying birds sense the field, it is too late for them to stop. To put it differently, this magnetic field method cannot stop birds hitting the windows or glasses in a short distance. They sense the field and will still collide with it no matter how.

Satisfaction undoubtedly is one of the most essential factors for people from all walks of life to continue making the best out of themselves. What would be more satisfied for them—having various works to do during the workday or doing the job all day long? In my perspective, I think workers would be way more content if they have a variety of works to do during the workday.

To begin with, by doing various works under a working day, workers can gain more working experience in their trade. Having more works to do means they are of importance in what they are doing in the profession. This is a demonstration of having one's professional skills or know-hows practiced and performed, which brings enormous satisfaction to the workers. As a good case in point, if a server working in a fast food restaurant only has one thing to do—taking orders, it makes him feel unwanted

and tedious in this job. Will that bring satisfaction to people? Will this make people set up their mind to improve themselves? The answer is definitely a NO. By having various kinds of works to do, workers learn through those works, being stimulated for thinking more. They can gain more experience and learn more things in the trade, which is priceless and it makes people satisfied.

In the second place, doing a variety of works in a workday enables workers to acquire professional knowledge in a faster way. Workers need more work to do in order to find out what they are unfamiliar with and what they excel at. For things they are not adept in, they can work harder since people have more opportunities to know this part through working more with different works. For the things that they are good at, they can maintain the skills and pass them down to other people or teach others who are not doing as good. Besides they can make great use of the time to improve their professional knowledge or techniques in a more rapid way as in the example of tourist guides, hotel receptionists who need more works to do to gain their expertise. Dealing with people is not easy and simply. This is a fulfillment of work in a professional way that will certainly bring satisfaction to people.

On the contrary, doing the same job all day long for a worker makes them gain experience and their professional knowledge in a slower pace. All workers need a variety of works to locate their weakness or inferiority in their jobs. For example, if a server works in a coffee shop who only does table cleaning job, he or she cannot learn how to deal with customers asking other services, such as the ingredients of the meal; he or she cannot learn how to make coffee or food. Doing the same job all day long makes people feel like a robot repeating things mechanically, which will certainly not bring out the sense of satisfaction. Who wants to work like a soul less robot? Additionally, this kind of job is just a "job" not a career on account of the fact that the worker will lack of enthusiasm and passion to do better and try their limits.

Things always have two opposite sides; some people must say that doing the same job all day long makes people focused only on such job. As a proverb says "Practice makes perfect." Doing the same job in a repeated way will spark new ideas or make people more professional since they do only the same job and will be more familiar with it for better improvement and this is also a fulfillment of jobs that brings great satisfaction. However, this is not true for most occupation. We are all human beings and we need a variety of works in order to learn, to try and to challenge, pushing ourselves to see how far we can go. Satisfaction itself can only be led out via a variety of works being performed rather than doing the same job all day long.






Background:

Coal ash, the toxic remains of coal burning in power plants, is full of chemicals that cause cancer, developmental disorders and reproductive problems. It poisons our water and kills fish and wildlife. Thus, do we need new or much stricter regulations on handling and storing coal ash?

Reading: We do not need that

- 1. We have set up regulations for the coal ash pond already; for example, companies need to use liner or closures to the pond to prevent hazardous chemicals reaching our drinking water sources and the protection is good enough.
- 2. New regulations scare buyers for the recycled coal ash.
- 3. Increasing the price of the coal would bring up the cost of electricity fee. The estimated increase for it will be ten times higher, which is not acceptable to the citizens.



Listening: We need stricter regulations for coal ash

The new EPA (Environmental Protection Agency) data confirms that we are just beginning to realize the threat coal ash dumps pose to drinking water supplies and the health of nearby communities. Thus, we do need a stricter law for regulating coal ash.

- 1. The regulation we established for coal ash ponds are just for the newly built ponds. In other words, the old ones are not regulated by the regulations. Thus, those old ponds will still contaminate our ground water and our drinking water will also be affected greatly in the end.
- 2. Coal ash contains a lot of poisonous chemicals, such as arsenal, mercury that are deadly for lives. Take mercury for an example. We have set up strict laws for the use of mercury since it is highly fatal to not just humans, but all living beings in the environment. However, still, people have been buying recycled mercury for over 50 years. Therefore, strict laws or regulations are not the cause making people not buying the item.
- 3. Indeed, if we increase the cost of coal, the electricity fee will be billions of dollars increased; however, this is not targeting only on certain individuals. In other words, the increased fee is evenly distributed to all the people using it. The price increasing is only one percent. So, it is not a big price to pay to have a cleaner environment.

Sample Writing:

This topic is about whether or not we should enact stricter laws or regulations on handling and storing coal ash since it pollutes our environment greatly. The reading and listening contents hold the different view on this issue.

Firstly, the reading says that the government has set up regulations for coal ash, such as building up liner to prevent it goes to our ground water; however, the listening indicates that the regulations are only valid for newly built storages or coal ash ponds. Thus, for the old storage places, it will still pose threats to our environment.

Secondly, the lecturer says that people will still make purchases on recycled coal ash even though the regulations are made stricter which is opposed to what the reading expresses. Besides, the speaker gives out an example to the concerns that people will not buy the coal ash, which is the cited case in the

listening—mercury. This is a high fatal element, yet with strict regulations, people are still buying it for over 50 years.

Thirdly, according to the speaker, there will admittedly have electricity fee increased if the price of coal is also increased. However, this is not a big deal if people can enjoy a safer and cleaner environment. For the increased price, it is even up by all the people using it, so there will only a one percent increase on the electricity fee. Yet, the reading says the fee will be augmented for as ten times as it originally is. Thus, the reading and the listening contents are contradictory on whether a stricter regulation should be practiced for the storage of coal ash.

Students were asked by teachers to behavior well in due manners in the classroom and the attitude they held to their duty as a student. Teachers nowadays simply have too many things to do in their own private life; they do not care much about how the student behave in the class as long as they hand in the homework and pass the exam; they think students can do whatever they want since their shared time involving each other is limited. Thus, they are not appreciated and valued by our society as much.

class, they need to either go to other schools or simply leave for their chores. Schools only pay them by classes or by hours, so they have lesser school commitment compared with teachers living in the past. Our society value and appreciate more about people who can devote themselves more to the school and the community. When the school or community need assistance, such as adult education programs or student club guidance, teachers in the past could readily be there and help out. Thus, they were more valued and appreciated by the society for their commitment to the neighborhood.



7. 綜合寫作:飛蛾撲火。

Three theories to explain why moths often fly towards artificial lights.

閱讀:

- (1) 飛蛾有本能,在 avoid predator such as frogs 的時候會 fly towards the moon,所以 moth 遇到 predator 的時候,看到 light 以為是 moon 就飛過去
- (2) 花在夜間會反射出比周圍亮的光,Moths often fly to flowers so they can suck the nectar (吸花蜜) from flowers. So when artificial light is on, they think it is the light from flowers.
- (3) 光源周圍的溫度高,Moths fly to artificial light because they want to heat themselves. 聽力:教授一一反駁。(請看整理)



Reading:

- (1) Why are moths attached to light? This behavior suggests that moths use the moon as a primary reference point and have the ability to calibrate their flight paths as the Earth's rotation causes the moon to move across the sky. In other words, when they are facing the predator such as frogs, they will fly towards the moon as their instinct to avoid them. Thus, flying towards to the artificial light, the moth might deem such light source as the moon and fly to it as biological drive for safety. So a moth's attraction to an artificial light or to a fire could be related to this biologic reaction. The moth wasn't "expecting" to actually get to "the moon" (the light source) or to be able to fly above it, so confusion results.
- (2) In the pitch dark night, the flowers can reflect the moon light in the surface, which makes them glow and look brighter in the environment; moths often fly to flowers so they can suck the nectar from flowers. They often hover near the flower and flap their wings hard while they sip the nectar. So when artificial light is on, they think it is the light from flowers.
- (3) Moths balance heat in the day time, while in the night time, when, especially in mountainous areas, the temperature drops, they need to heat themselves up and keep warm. Hence, moths fly to artificial light because they want to heat themselves.

Listening:

- (1) Moths circle around the artificial light and even collide into each other when they fly. They also fly much longer than necessary, even long after the predator is gone. So the instinctive behavior relating to predator is not sound. Besides, if the moon theory is valid, moths would only be flying upwards towards the light source above rather than circling.
- (2) Moths detect the presence of flowers because they can detect the CO2 that these flowers release, not because there is light around the flower. It has been found that moths can detect the kind of flower and the richness of the flower from the amount of CO2 that these flowers release. Since artificial light does not release any CO2, the "flower theory" is also flawed.
- (3) If the "heat theory" is reasonable, then moths would be flying towards some types of light more than others. For example, they would fly into florescent light much less because florescent light is cold and it does not generate much heat for them. But on the contrary, moths prefer to fly into florescent light rather than other warmer lights.



Sample Answer:

The reading and the listening content are holding different perspectives about the theories on the explanation why moths fly towards the artificial lights.

To begin with, the reading indicates moths fly towards the moon out of instinct trying to avoid their predators, such as frogs. Yet the lecture says this is not logical for they fly longer and simply just cycle the light source and not fly above. Besides, when the warning sign of predator is gone, they still do such behavior.

Secondly, the speaker indicates that moths fly to the flowers because they can detect the CO2 amount released from the flowers, not because of the glow reflected by the flowers from the moon in the dark. Besides, artificial lights do not ooze such CO2 thing, yet the moths are still rushing to chase the light. However, the reading argues that moths fly towards the light due to the simulation of flying to the flower that glows and brighter in the environment so they can get the nectar there.

Lastly, moths fly to artificial light due to the fact that they want to heat themselves from the cold night. Likewise, the listening passage refutes this point denoting moths would fly into florescent light much often, yet florescent light is cold and it does not generate much heat for them. They do not like to fly to the light source which, in comparison, is warmer. Hence, the content from each source is totally opposing.


Background knowledge for this phenomenon in Chinese:→ 之前閱讀也考過同主題

為什麼飛蛾會撲火?一般有兩個解釋。

【解釋一】: 科學家經過長期觀察和實驗,終於揭開了「撲火」之謎。他們發現飛蛾等昆蟲在夜間飛行活動時,是依靠月光來判定方向的。飛蛾總是使月光從一個方向投射到它的眼裡。飛蛾在逃避蝙蝠的追逐,或者繞過障礙物轉彎以後,它只要再轉一個彎,月光仍將從原先的方向射來,它也就找到了方向。這是一種「天文導航」。飛蛾看到燈光,錯誤地認為是「月光」。因此,它也用這個假「月光」來辨別方向。月亮距離地球遙遠得很,飛蛾只要保持同月亮的固定角度,就可以使自己朝一定的方向飛行。可是,燈光距離飛蛾很近,飛蛾按本能仍然使自己同光源保持著固定的角度,於是只能繞著燈光打轉轉,直到最後精疲力盡而死去。

【解釋二】: 許多昆蟲,只在夕陽西下,夜幕降臨後才飛行於花間,一面採蜜,一面為植物授粉。漆黑的夜晚,它們能順利地找到花朵,是「閃光語言」的功勞。夜行昆蟲在空中飛翔時,由於翅膀的振動,不斷與空氣摩擦,產生熱能,發出紫外光來向花朵「問路」, 花朵因紫外光的照射,激起暗淡的「夜光」回波,發出熱情的邀請;昆蟲身上的特殊構造接收到花朵「夜光」的回波,就會顧波飛去,為花傳粉作媒,使其結果,傳遞後代。這樣,昆蟲的燈語也為大自然的繁榮作出了貢獻。因此,夜行昆蟲大多有趨光性,「飛蛾撲火」就是這一習性的真實寫照。另外,其實飛蛾主觀上也不是想死在火焰裡面,是由於其複眼的構造使其以一個螺旋角度圍繞火飛行的時候逐漸接近最後造成撲火。

飛蛾撲火,其實飛蛾只是保持自己的飛行方向與光源成一定角度,隨著它不斷的飛,它要不斷變化角度的, 而軌跡也逐漸靠近光源,就好像蚊香的形狀一樣,繞著光源飛,並且半徑逐漸縮小,最後接觸光源,如果 不幸是繞著火苗飛,那麼.....並不是徑直撲向光源的。



Background knowledge for this phenomenon in English:

1. 月光

Some entomologists believe moths zoom toward unnatural light sources because the lights throw off their internal navigation systems. Moths didn't evolve around bright lights, after all; they evolved at a time when all the light on Earth came solely from the distant sun, moon and stars. In a behavior called transverse orientation, some insects navigate by flying at a constant angle relative to a distant light source, such as the moon. But around man-made lights, such as a campfire or your porch light, the angle to the light source changes as a moth flies by. This confuses it. "The thinking is that they become dazzled by the light and are somehow attracted," said Jerry Powell, an entomologist at the University of California, Berkeley, who specializes in moths.

This theory runs into some problems, however. Light bulbs may be new on evolutionary time scales, but campfires have been around for about 400,000 years. Wouldn't natural selection have killed off moths whose instinct tells them to go kamikaze every time they feel blinded by the light? Furthermore, moths may not even use transverse navigation. "I'm dubious of the idea that they're using moonlight as an orienting device in the first place," Powell told Life's Little Mysteries. "That would probably only be done by species that migrate — in that process they might use the moon in some way. But that would not explain why the 50 or 70 percent of moths that are small and don't migrate would also use moonlight to navigate."

A completely different theory was first put forth in the 1970s by Philip Callahan, an entomologist then working with the U.S. Department of Agriculture. Callahan discovered that the infrared light spectrum emitted by a candle flame happens to contain a few of the exact same frequencies of light given off by female moths' pheromones, or sex hormones. Callahan had previously discovered that the pheromones are luminescent — they glow very faintly. In short, male moths are attracted to candles under the false belief that they are females sending out sex signals. "The male moth is highly attracted to and dies attempting to mate with the candle flame," Callahan wrote in a 1977 paper in Applied Optics.

This hypothesis has its holes, too. According to Powell, ultraviolet light is far more attractive to insects of various kinds, including moths, than infrared light is. And there's no reason why UV light should remind moths of sex; it doesn't contain the same wavelengths as their glowing pheromones. Entomologists have found that moths are less attracted to artificial lights during the week of the full moon than they are during the new moon week, and this observation sparked yet another theory. "People used to say you don't capture many moths with UV lamps at the time of the full moon because they're all flying toward the moon," Powell said. "But that's ridiculous, because they can't carry on their life cycles if they're flying to the moon."

And indeed, the notion has been proven incorrect. "A study done in Scandinavia found out that it's not that they aren't attracted to lights as much when the moon is bright, it's that they aren't as active during that time because the light doesn't drop off as much at night," he said. Usually, he explained, nightfall and darkness trigger moth activity. So no hypothesis holds water. Why is a moth "like a moth to a flame?" For now, the question must remain one of life's biggest little mysteries.

2. 月光+採蜜

What would a summer evening be without moths? They flutter around our campfires and beat their powdery wings against our lampshades. They congregate by streetlights and frequent torch-lit garden parties. But what is it about the lamp on your porch that moths find so irresistible? Is it the warmth? The pleasing glow? Why are moths attracted to light? According to Mike Saunders, the answer is simple: They're not. "Moths often use the moon to orient themselves during night flight," explains Saunders, a professor of entomology at Penn State. In visual terms, the moon appears at "optical infinity," i.e., far enough away that the rays of light it reflects toward Earth are parallel as they enter a moth's (or a human's) eye. This constant makes an excellent navigational tool. "Using the moon as a reference, moths can sustain linear flight in a given direction."

But technology has been unkind to the moth. "Artificial lights seem brighter than the moon," Saunders notes, "and moths end up orienting to them even though the artificial light is not at optical infinity." The moon remains safely out of reach, but a candle or lamp is a different story. As the moths get closer to the light, their ability to triangulate is thrown off." As to why moths tend to remain close to a light source once they have reached it, Saunders speculates that the poor creatures simply tire themselves out. "If they spend significant time circling the light, they may exhaust themselves, quit flying, and rest on nearby objects."

Some researchers have suggested that, having reached a brightly lighted spot, a nocturnal moth is tricked into thinking the sun is out, and settles in to sleep. Another theory holds that candle flames emit wavelengths similar to those of female moth pheromones, attracting male moths intent on romance. Yet another attributes the moth seems fondness for light to the search for food. Most moths are nocturnal, and many feed on the nectar of flowers, which often reflect ultraviolet light. They may mistake artificial ultraviolet light for a potential food source. "It is certainly possible that night-blooming flowers are detected by moths as a function of reflected moonlight," says Saunders. But nocturnal moths have other means of finding their nighttime meals, he adds. "Recent research indicates that the moth is capable of detecting high levels of CO2 being emitted by flowers. It is believed that these high CO2 levels signal increased metabolic activity in the flower, which may tip off the moth to the presence of nectar."

While these explanations may account for some light-seeking moth behavior, the vast majority are drawn to light due to navigational snafus, says Saunders. "One caveat," he notes, "is that there are many, many species of moth. Not all moths are nocturnal fliers, and maybe there are moths out there that are genuinely attracted to lights. But in general, it's just not true."

As a Chinese old adage goes, "Giving people fish, we can only feed them one meal; by teaching them how to fish, we feed them a lifetime," for education, the most important goal is not just lying on the period when people are being educated as in school, but on how to motivate them to learn more. Thus, in my perspective, being able to teach people how to educate themselves continuously should be the most essential destination of education.

To being with, education is a process of leaning and self-teaching for the most appropriate ways of each individual. In other word, education should not just be confined to the learning itself. This is limited and is not catering to the potential of each individual. For example, when students are learning math at school, they cannot just learn and follow the rules or skills from teachers. Instead, they should learn how to figure out the process of the rules being formulated in essence. Teachers teach at school, while students are being inspired to teach themselves by their own way and altitude. Maybe the promising result cannot be reached in a short time, yet the most important goal of education has reached—self-teaching—. One day, the student can understand the difficult formula by referring to more data relevant. Thus, education is to make learning takes place by inducing the self-teaching process.

Secondly, if people are not taught how to educate themselves, education can be a standstill/stalemate. With the era of the Internet arriving, all the data and information are being updated too fast. Take medicine for an example. Some drugs are introduced to new patients for specific purpose; they are proved potent in this minute, yet in the next minute, they are recalled due to certain complications attached to them. If the education of medical school aims at teaching students to self-educate

themselves as the most important goal, they can continue the search and further the formula of the drug. This is beneficial to all the human beings. On the contrary, if the goal of the medical education is not focusing on motivating people to teach themselves for the betterment, future doctors are just acquiring the knowledge of today and following the rule from the previous generations. This is a complete motionless process and the drug would not be improved saving more lives.

Thirdly, most great achievements are done by the process of self-teaching. In other words, the most important goal of education should be to prepare, for instance, children for life, nourishing the potential in every child so that each may connect and contribute his or her unique ideas and abilities to society, such as the invention of antibiotics, alternating current, short as AC, nutrition supplements, environmental-friendly garments and so forth. Those special characteristics of idea are brought about by the most important goal of education—teaching people how to educate themselves, not just in learning from a fixed way, but in testing, in experiencing and in trying for their own need and interest. Thus, such education will then achieve a world never before known—starting a great chapter of human history.

Admittedly, education is broad and some people might think that the most important goal of education should be only be restricted to the category of teaching people how to educate themselves in their likings. Education should be an empowering process that allows and guides learners to develop their passions, critical thinking, compassion, and orientation towards wisdom and towards the world in which we live. Namely, the most important goal of education should be boundless and not limited only to teach people how to educate themselves. The most significant goal of education is to make people the best people they can be, to be passionate about life, to be able to help others, to ponder over questions and so on. Nevertheless, we are living in a world of reality of which we need to make constant efforts to make things perfect and this cannot be conquered by being encouraged by education that teaches people how to educate themselves; how to improve themselves by the self-learning process; and how to actively learn new things for their ultimate goals. Thus, I agree with our statement. Education, after all, is a process of self-searching and self-teaching.


8. 綜合寫作:如何提高太空船安全。

- (3) laser broom 有可能會被用於建造軍事 weapons,用在太空中造成 controversial。




Reading:

- 1. The scientist can try to track the orbit of the debris or space junk. By tracking them down, usually with a regular orbit, spaceship can predict the possible collision beforehand protecting the safety of spaceship.
- 2. By constructing a field outside the spaceship with a special metal that endures temperature, spaceship can be protected in the collision.
- 3. Using the laser broom method, such as the military utilize in their mission, this sweep out the debris in the way and will protect the spaceship from collide with numerous debris and space objects with efficiency.

Listening:

The consequences of meteoroid and debris impacts on spacecraft can range from small surface pits due to micrometer-size impactors, via clear hole penetrations for millimeter-size objects, to mission-critical damage for projectiles larger than one centimeter.

- For protecting spaceship colliding with debris, tracking debris is not a sound idea. Only larger space objects can be catalogued and tracked; only these can be avoided through active measures or by evasive maneuvers. Smaller, catalogued objects can only be defeated by passive protection techniques
- 2. By mimicking the natural protective environment of the Earth, the researchers try to use a metal field as a powerful deflector shield. However, the amount of high-temperature metal required to protect a large vehicle like the Space Shuttle Orbiter would have been very heavy and entailed a severe penalty to the vehicle's performance. We need to develop more powerful rocket to deliver the spaceship to the space. The challenge is harder for us. Thus, this consumes more power and also would possibly be disturbing all the way.
- 3. A laser 'broom' intended to clear space junk out of the orbit path to protect the spaceship is not working. However, this is breaching international treaties preventing the use of laser weapons in space, some people suspect the technology of being linked with missile defence projects. So it is too controversial.




Sample Answer:

The topic—how to protect airspace from hitting the debris—, the listening content and the reading passage hold a different stand on the protecting effect and result.

First of all, the lecturer says that tracking the debris does not generate high successful rate because only larger space debris or objects can be really tracked and recorded, yet smaller objects are still harmful, many are destructive, to spaceship. The reading however indicates that the spaceship can track the debris and avoid them for a safe navigation.

Secondly, the reading shows that building a metal shield outside the spaceship can help protect it from the debris. However, the listening content says this kind of special metal will only increase the weight of the spaceship, which makes it more awkward in operation; besides such powerful deflector shield entails more energy for the construction stage. This cause more trouble than its worth.

Thirdly, the lecturer says that laser broom is too controversial to be used in the space. For such laser broom, it can be used in the military concern, which violates the international agreement, although it may be an efficient way to clear up the debris in the way of the spaceship. The reading only concerns about efficiency of the issue, not about other issues that may breach the space treaties. All in all, the content of the two sources is contradictory in the approach for assisting the spaceship a safe journey.



8. 獨立寫作:教育對老年人一樣重要。

Do you agree or disagree with the following statement? Is it just as important for older people to study and learn new things as it is for younger people too?

"Live and learn" as the proverb goes. In terms of learning new things, it is not concerning the matter of age. We, young and old, should all try to learn new things in this rapid change era. It is of importance for them not just to sit on their laurels for what have been made, but to learn and study new technology, new science and new perspectives of the knowledge to further their work, which can also be improved by their experience. Young people learn new things due to their mobility in the society for survival, while the older people learn new things to keep abreast of the new world and further their knowledge. What they do is both vital to the world.

Admittedly, some people may think that it is not a priority for older people to learn new things. They can simply just live in their comfort zone and use their old ways of living in their life. For one thing, they may have made contributions to the world and that will be enough. For another, they do not need to compete

with people from all over the world in this global village under the fierce competition for a job. Learning or studying new things might be overwhelming and a burden to people their age. Those statements however are misleading and erroneous. For instance, firstly, the comfort zone needs to be updated. It is highly inconvenient to write a letter to someone and wait for days in reply. It is exhausting and time-consuming to travel overseas by boat than by airplane. Maybe they do not need to compete with people for a job as younger people do, yet they learn and study new things for a more decent life and for improving what they have been doing in the betterment of all mankind.

Reading: (Different species of whale orca are spotted by the scientists.)

Orca is a species of Killer whales that are starkly black that when you see an all-white one. It's pretty amazing. Scientists have spotted an extremely rare all-white adult orca off Russia's coast and are wondering if it's the same animal photographed by scientists in Alaska in 2000 and 2010 — or if there is more than one. The two sighting spots for the adult orca are 1,500 miles away from each other. Thus, with all evidence, the all-white adult orca being seen is a whale of different species.

Firstly, the color is different; for the first spotted whale, it is completely white, yet for the other whale, it is grayish while.

Secondly, the distance between the two sightings is around 1,500 miles, which is too far away for the same whale to swim along the coastal area.

Thirdly, in the first sighting on the whale, from the size of its dorsal fin, it suggested that it was at least 20 years old. This was happened in the year 2,000. For the second sighting in 2010, it would be 30 years old for the whale, which is not possible and rare.

Listening: (YES, the two sightings of the whale are the same species of all-white whale.)

Firstly, the feeding areas of the all-while orca are usually abundant of algae. As is known, the color of algae varies according to different reasons. In other words, the whale's skin color can be affected by the color of algae that are grown in different seasons. Thus, we are still talking about the same species of whale orca, but the skin color is changed or covered by the algae. The skin looks different in color, but the true color is actually unchanged.

Secondly, all-white adult orca can be divided into two types. One is addressed "hunting type" another one is just called fishing type that feed on fish by "flowing" on the water. So, With the drifting of ice bergs, such fishing type whale can something move with the ice bergs for 2,000 miles in an easy way. The distance of 1,500 miles between the two documented sightings is not much of a difficult thing for them.

Thirdly, the whale's age can be deceiving. To put it differently, the scientist guessed the age of the whale by the fin, which seems right; however, the fin cannot accurately tell the difference for a whale that is 20 years old or a whale that is 30 years old. With this fact, what if the whale was 25 years old when it was spotted and guessed as 20 years old. So, the "fin" theory is weak.

Sample Writing:

The topic being discussed is about whether or not the same species of all-white whale orca spotted in two different places. The arguments in the both material are opposing.

To begin with, from the reading, it says that the skin color of whale is changed from white to greyish white; thus, there is no way the same species is spotted. However, from the listening, it indicates that the feeding ground of such whale is full of algae that can affect the color of how the whale looks like. To be more specific, the algae's color varies based on seasons. So, the whale just looks different in color, yet they are still the same in the skin color.

Secondly, this all-white creature can be divided into two types of whale—the hunting whales and the fishing whales—. The latter can move around flowing with ice bergs for food, which is fish. From the reading, it says that 1,500 miles for the two sighting spots are too far way, yet the listening says, for the fishing type whale, drifting 2,000 miles is not too difficult.

Thirdly, it may be a misleading observation for telling the age of the whale. From the reading, it says, the

fin revealing the age of whale for the first sighting is 20 years old, so the second time would be 30 years old, which is not possible; however, for the listening, it is not easy to accurately distinguish the age by observing the fin. Besides, 20 and 30 years old of a whale may look similar in the observation of the fin. In other words, the whale spotted twice is the same species. Therefore, the reading and the listening contents are contradictory.

Sample Writing:

The issue of "grade" cannot be overemphasized among students as well as teachers. Students attending schools are usually setting their goals of obtaining high grades, which can be deemed as the reward of their diligence performed in the learning process. Some students prefer the grade being determined by many short assignments, while others prefer it being based on one or two long assignments. Personally, I would choose my grade is based on many short assignments, rather than being decided in one or two long assignment.

To begin with, for students, one of the best methods to evaluate their understanding about the coursework is through many short assignments. Learning is a process, not something that can be reached in the shortest time possible. Even the brainiest kids often encounter learning problems. Thus, if students' grade is based on many short assignments, they can read and study more often on the scope the assignment sets. In other words, they can find out their weakness or problems via many assignments and work out those problems. Some subjects, such as math, chemistry or physics, are based on gradual comprehension of the rudimentary knowledge. If students do not solve their questions, they may have hard time understanding the lesson.

Secondly, it is more efficient for teachers to give out feedback. With many short assignments practiced, students can frequently receive the feedback from teachers who can therefore give out step-to-step answers or guidance to each student. Each short assignment provides stimuli to students who can

definitely learn better at school. On the contrary, if students' grade is based on only one or two long assignments, students cannot receive timely feedback from teachers. There would be tons of questions revealing from students who only acquire their grades from one or two long assignments. Exhausted, teachers would be dealing with so many questions in one go, which will decrease the efficiency of learning as a whole. Additionally, due to less evaluation, teachers might not be sure about the fact that students perceive the subject he or she teaches. Thus, the outcome will not be as promising as frequent short assignments do.

(自曝其短) With many short assignments, students, admittedly, will feel bothered and annoying that they might end up doing slacking work for all the short assignments. Even if students are all seriously about those short assignments and make all the efforts to achieve high score, they will feel constant pressure for the frequent submission of assignment. However, assignments divided into shorter ones enable students to gradually learn the subject little by little. They might fail a few times, yet they can make it up by studying industriously. Besides, teachers can always help out in the process of their learning and adjusting the level for the course based on students' grades. The advantages far outweigh the petty shortcomings.

In order to provide the best learning approach to students in terms of giving grades, teachers are debating over whether or not they need to give grades based on many short assignments or on one or two long assignments. To me, apparently, I prefer the grades given in accordance to many short assignments. The major goal for young students is to learn in a process when they can adjust their learning steps and strategies based on many smaller assignments, not on just one or two that determine their academic performance.



4. Do you agree or disagree? For successful development of a country, should a government focus its budget more on very young children (5 to 10 years old) education rather than on universities?

High education quality has a significant relationship with the countries' future and development. Secondly, each education system has a major channel to acquire budgets. In other words, when it comes to the source of fund, primary schools, in my country, do not just obtain their fees mainly from the government, but also the local businessmen and companies, while universities depend mainly on the government investment. To improve awareness and publicize the image, many entrepreneurs donate money to build primary schools or set up scholarships for the future elites. For universities, however, as mentioned above, since they need a large amount of investment for facilities or improvements, regular companies cannot afford such investment. Under this circumstance, government investment is the only way out. According to a survey by my country, Taiwan, more than 80 percent of primary and secondary schools receive monetary support from local businessmen, while not many universities receive donation from companies. In light of this, government investment is the only source of university education while primary schools can get outlay from other sources.

Last but not least, considering the different role in a country's development, it can be seen easily that universities are more substantial than primary schools. What is the aim of university education? Besides developing more talents in different areas, universities also shoulder the task of promoting country's science and technology level, which is the core of a country's competitiveness. In universities, there is much scientific research, which requires lots of money and support. In contrast, since students in primary schools can only learn some basic knowledge, it is worthless to invest large amounts of money on them. For instance, in America, government invested more than 5 billion dollars to its top 10 universities research, which is one of the most important reasons for America's prosperity. Admittedly, government investing more on the children education must have its merits to some extent. 5. Do you agree or disagree? The most important characteristic of a political or business leader is the ability to be responsible for mistakes.

What is the most important characteristic for a political or a business leader? Is that the ability of taking full responsibility for the mistakes committed? Or it is based on other characteristics, such as being honest, or having the courage to lead the specific group for a resourceful era? As for me, I hold the viewpoint that the most essential characteristic of such leaders is to possess the faculty of taking the responsibility for mistakes.

Firstly, leaders can inspire people in the same group for the sense of responsibility as well as bring timely correction for the mistakes. To put it more exactly, when a business leader admits the mistakes in front of his employees and is willing to tackle it, he or she not only corrects the mistake in time, but sets a positive example to employees of being honest, giving employees the nerve to face the difficulty. This behavior will bring the awareness of facing obstacles, be it intentionally or unintentionally, and learning to take the responsibility for the betterment of all other relevant policies or projects for either business leaders or political ones. In addition, by taking the responsibility for the mistake, leaders will be more conscious and heedful of their behaviors or style of thinking when, for example, making policies or negotiating with other firms. As a result, the organization or citizens will be stronger and really benefit from the mistakes.

Secondly, leaders can really bring the true advantage for either employees or citizens with such characteristic. For political leaders, if they can have the ability to take the responsibility for mistakes, it, in essence, means they are honest with what they do. When it is not right or being considered a mistake, the political leaders are willing to adjust and make corrections for the benefits of most people. For example, the plan for establishing a dam that is close to a mountainous area; however, it will hurt nature there as well as people living in the vicinity who are relying on this natural area. After further evaluation, if that place is not appropriate for a dam, the leaders are to take the responsibility. Even though money has been spent and plans have been made, it is a mistake and leaders should have the "guts" to take full responsibility and accept criticism. So, this is the most important characteristic for a political leader. On the same line, such characteristic also applies to business leaders who can also correct and stop wasting time or money if the strategy is not working out.

Admittedly, some people may think that other characteristics, such as integrity, the ability of carrying out a project or even the ability of talking are also of the greatest importance. However, as we know, everyone makes mistakes. It is not the behavior itself that will make a great leader stand out, but the ability to try to make things better; to me, it is the heart that is set to take the full responsibility of a mistake—this is above integrity or performing a task, but to set a good example for other leaders as well as people working for them.

The global world of work has seen radical changes in recent years, among which telecommuting, or working from home, stands out as the most remarkable brainchild of this technological age. An increasing number of people choose to complete their work at home and communicate with their offices using computers or telephones. This kind of work atmosphere can never be created in a home environment no matter how sophisticated the technology is.

Finally, once people start working away from the office, there is a decreased sense of working for an institution but instead an increased sense of working for a task or a product. Therefore, workers may feel less loyal to a company and more inclined to change jobs or work part-time or on contract, as long as it can provide reasonable pay and a flexible work schedule. Working in the office, on the other hand, often gives people a sense of belonging, a feeling that they are part of a larger group.

Apart from the disadvantages already mentioned, there are also drawbacks including loneliness, isolation, the initial high cost of setting up, domestic distractions and interruptions etc. Therefore, this modern, seemingly attractive mode of working is actually not as efficient and rewarding as working in the office.
