

2015 年 6 月 6 日: Bar (三级命中)

The chart shows the average class size in six countries in 2006, and compares them with world average class size.



Sample Answer:

The bar chart shows the differences in the class size between primary school and lower secondary school in six nations in the year 2006. Generally, the class size in primary school was slightly larger than that in lower secondary school in the world average category.


It is clear that only two Asian countries figures were higher than the world average in terms of average number in primary school (26), with 34 in South Korea and 27 persons in Japan respectively, followed closely by Britain (22). Meanwhile, the figures for Denmark and Mexico were similar, at nearly 21 persons. Finally, Iceland had the smallest class size compared with other countries, with only around 15 pupils having a class at the same time.

As for the class size in lower secondary schools, South Korea still had the largest figure, with 36 students. By contrast, Iceland had the lowest number, at only a half of South Korea's. Also, the numbers in Japan and Mexico both exceeded that of world average, a little higher than 30.

Overall, South Korea had the biggest class size while Iceland had the smallest in two types of schools in the given chart. Only UK and Denmark's class sizes in primary schools were slightly larger than that in their lower secondary schools.

2015 年 5 月 21 日: Bar (一级命中)

The charts shows the percentages of male and female students getting top grades in 1960 and 2000.



The two bar charts compare the proportions of boys and girls who achieved high grades in five subjects.

Overall, it can be seen that the percentage of boys getting top grades experienced an upward trend in humanities and arts. In 1996, about only 20% and 10% of boys obtained high grades in humanities and arts, and these two proportions almost doubled in 2002 respectively. As for mathematics and science, the figures decreased significantly. The percentage of male students who performed well in science decreased considerably, standing at 18% in 2000. It is interesting to note that there was no change in the percentages of languages (around 22%).

By contrast, the proportions of girls achieved A or A+ in humanities, arts and languages dropped remarkably, which fell by 15%, 7%, 5% respectively in the year 2000, while the percentage of girls getting high grades tripled in mathematics.

To sum up, girls outperformed boys in languages and arts, whereas boys were more skilled in science and mathematics.



The flow chart illustrates how to process coca beans into different products.

It is clear that there are three stages in this process, from the initial whole beans to the final products on the market.

At the first stage, the whole beans are picked from the cacao tree. After being picked, their outer shells are removed and they are dried for the next stage. Stage two consists of many steps. On the one hand, some of the dried beans are processed into coca cake, and then in the next stage, these cakes are ground into cocoa powder and cocoa liquor, which are the raw material for making a variety of cakes and drinks. On the other hand, other beans would be mixed with sugar to produce industrial chocolate. Finally, these finished chocolate would be sold to the consumer.

Most countries believe that international tourism have harmful effects. Why do they think so? How to change their views?

Travelling abroad has become a new lifestyle nowadays. However, complaints about the potential negative effects of international travel have been sparked among the public in recent years. This essay will outline two main reasons for these complaints and provide certain measures to change the opinion.

First of all, it is a widespread phenomenon that foreign travellers might repel the local community because of their inappropriate languages and behaviour in some resorts. Due to the cultural differences, visitors' behavior may break traditional rules in travel destinations sometimes. For example, a visitor will annoy an Indian when he passes food by his left hand. For this reason, the local government can take actions to provide more specific travelling tips in popular scene spots for foreign travellers.

In addition, more and more transnational travels will cause damage to the unique nature of a culture. Foreign visitors will bring not only tangible matters like food and clothes but also something intangible, such as their festivals or customs. In other words, these visitors are assimilating their country's culture while they are travelling abroad, which will be bound to cause antipathy in racist society. Germany is a case in point. For this reason, the government can encourage locals to hold a tolerant attitude toward foreign arrivals as they have no common knowledge of local conventions in most times. Travelling is for cultural communication instead of invasion.

In conclusion, breaking conventions and cultural uniqueness are the two main factors leading to the bias regarding international tourism. Both governments and individuals should make an effort to change this phenomenon.

In some countries around the world men and women are having children late in life. What are the reasons for this development? What are the effects on society and family life?

In the modern world, young adults prefer to raise children late in their life. This essay will mainly analyse the potential reasons and how it will affect society and family life as well.

There are three main factors contributing to the postponed parenthood. In general, people who bear great pressure from their work are less likely to prepare childbirth early, considering that they may have little time to attend their children. This problem can also be attributed to the high cost of modern life. The young people without adequate savings will probably be afraid of high living cost and expensive tuition. Another reason for this is the difficulty in balancing work and life. More young people emphasise the promotion in career, and thus spare little time for a stable marriage life which is viewed as a significant element for rearing children.

It cannot be denied that late childbirth is able to provide more time for young couples to be ready for the new members in their families. They need to learn how to raise children before they decide to have children. In addition, if they delay childbirth, they can provide more economic support for children's rearing and education.

However, the low birthrate will cause an increase in ageing population. It is widely known that most medical needs and costs occur in the last years of life. Therefore, young people have to face the need to care for the elderly family members. From the perspective of the society, due to a shift

in the age structure of the workforce, an ageing society with a low birthrate is likely to encounter labour shortage.

To summarise, the delay in having children is mainly attributed to the stresses and strains men and women bear in both their life and work. Although this may help them better prepare for their children's development, the negative effects on both society and family life cannot be ignored.

Nowadays, whether evaluating and criticising teachers should be supported in the classroom has become a controversial issue. From my perspective, evaluation and criticism of teachers are necessary for the improvement of education if they are objective and reasonable.

On the one hand, proposing changes to teachers' lesson content contributes to the improvement of teaching quality. Usually, it is difficult for teachers to realise the mistakes and slips in their teaching unless students remind them. Additionally, teachers may not clearly know what students have known and want to know when planning their lessons. If students can put forward their ideas and suggestions towards the lesson, it will be of great help for teachers to upgrade the teaching projects. Moreover, trying to evaluate teachers' lesson is particularly beneficial for students' academic and career development in the future. The modern education emphasises criticism and innovation. Undoubtedly, it is an effective way for students to debate or discuss with teachers.

On the other hand, the disruptive students will probably disturb the class and negatively affect both teaching and learning outcomes. When students voice their opinions in the classroom, it will be hard to maintain the order and discipline and the teachers may feel disrespected. Also, students will suffer a loss in terms of knowledge and other learning content. This is because teachers always devote much to delivering knowledge and explaining theories. If they are disrupted, the teaching plan may not be able to be fulfilled. As a result, both teachers and students have to face a loss in the quality of education.

To sum up, it can be recommended that students evaluate and criticise teachers in the classroom on the premise that they have decent manners without disturbing the learning atmosphere. Only in this way will teachers and students achieve a win-win outcome in education.
